54%

of girls are pregnant within 12-18 months of leaving foster care

50%

do not complete high school

20%

Struggle with homelessness²

The Facts:

There are an estimated 400,000 children in foster care in the U.S.

Foster kids suffer from Post Traumatic Stress Disorder at almost two times the rate of returning veterans.

Some foster children experience eight or more foster placements. (That's eight homes that the child moves in and out of and lost opportunities for lifelong bonds with peers and adults).

In 2013, more than 23,000 young people aged out of foster care with no permanent family to end up with. ¹

PROGRAMS

Camp Felix East

In 2015, 186 New York City youth attended Camp Felix.

Our programs allow children, so many of whom work with Social Workers, Therapists, Special Educators and Lawyers throughout the year, to just be kids.

From swim instruction to art and theater, to climbing, nature exploration and dance, the kids we serve are able to overcome fears, try new activities, and form bonds with dedicated staff members and with campers who share a similar background.

 The impact of Felix's programs is life-long.


In 2015

- 4 former campers have moved to Camp Felix employee.




These opportunities help our youth build job experience, enhance their leadership skills, and expand their resumes to prepare them for their professional careers.
